The Youth Entrepreneurship Alliance (YEA) is a national policy strategy group that is emerging in 2009-10 to continue to bring the message of the importance of youth entrepreneurship education to the attention of national leaders that can be advocates and help the field expand. It started as 12 national organizations that emerged from the Youth Entrepreneurship Strategy Group, an Aspen Institute initiative, that ended in June, 2009.
